KFL&A Public Health Orders Face Coverings Mandatory in Commercial and Municipal Establishments effective 12:01 a.m. on June 27, 2020

Emergency Declaration

North Frontenac declared a [State of Emergency](#) effective March 27, 2020 and is in effect until further notice.

Township Office

Residents

Kingston, Frontenac, Lennox & Addington (KFL&A) Public Health is continuing to advise everyone to stay home as much as possible, to stay local and avoid unnecessary travel. Enjoy your community, plan activities close to home within your own region, support your local economy, and local businesses. Social gatherings limits have been expanded to up to 50 people indoors and 100 people outdoors effective Friday July 17th. People must still practice [physical distancing](#) and [wear a mask](#) (inside) by keeping at least two meters (6 ft) away from others outside their [social bubble](#) (maximum of 10 people).

Council Meetings

Council Meetings will be held using electronic participation. Details on how the public will be able to access the Meetings will be posted on the Township's website prior to the Meetings or by contacting the Clerk's Department.

Property Taxes

Penalty & Interest relief to include May 1, 2020 (providing two months relief) and to not charge Penalty and Interest on any unpaid 2020 levied taxes only (not prior years) for the months of June, July and August of 2020.

Waste Facilities

Waste Sites and Household Hazardous Waste Depot are open and [protocols](#) are in place for safe dumping – please follow signs at Waste Sites. The Re-Use Centre will not be opening until 2021.

Recreation

- Playgrounds will be opening soon; awaiting guidance from Public Health.
- Community Halls will remain closed; awaiting guidance from Public Health.
- All other [Recreational Facilities](#), including the [North Frontenac Parklands](#) are open; while following Public Health Guidelines.
- Public Beaches are open; however, [Guidelines](#) shall be followed.
- [Kingston-Frontenac Public Libraries](#) will continue curb-side pick-up and will re-open soon. The Township's [Public Internet Outreach Program](#) will resume July 22nd (Plevna) and July 23rd (Cloyne), subject to only having 2 occupants in the library at one time, physical distancing, masking and practicing good hand hygiene. We advise everyone to follow the signage posted at the Libraries.

Building Department

Building Permits are being issued and Building Inspections are being performed with appropriate physical distancing, subject to the Township's [Entry Pre-Screening Checklist](#).
