

Voter Eligibility

You can vote if you are:

- A Canadian Citizen; and
- At least 18 years of age; and
- A resident of North Frontenac; or
- A non-resident of North Frontenac, but you or your spouse own or rent property in the Municipality; and
- Are not prohibited from voting under any law

You may only vote once in the Township of North Frontenac municipal elections regardless of how many properties you own or rent within the municipality. You may also vote in multiple Municipal Elections if you own property outside of the Township of North Frontenac.

- Change school support for the purpose of voting in a school board election.
