

**NOTES OF A MEETING OF THE NORTH FRONTENAC CENOTAPH TASK FORCE HELD ON FEBRUARY 22<sup>ND</sup>, 2013 AT 9:30 AM AT THE CLAR MILL FIRE HALL UPSTAIRS MEETING ROOM.**

Present: Councillor Gerry Martin (Chair), Councillor Wayne Good, Eileen Flieler, Cor Bakelaar, and Corey Klatt – Manager of Community Development (MCD).

Absent with Regrets: Mayor Bud Clayton and Bob Kenney

9:30 am – Meeting called to order

Present members approved the notes from the February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 Inaugural meeting of the Cenotaph Task Force.

Discussion ensued regarding an appropriate location for the proposed Cenotaph. Councillor Martin advised he had looked at the local school property and the area we had previously discussed is in a very low lying area which is swampy. He also suggested it may not be a good idea to be looking at the property at the old Millars store in Plevna as the MOE is still monitoring one well there. He also spoke with a land owner close to the school who advised they would not be interested in having the Cenotaph on their property. It was also determined that the old MNR site would not likely be a good option for a Cenotaph as there could be other proposed uses for that property in the future and at this time it may not be a good idea to have groups of people there when it is being used mostly for a work space.

Councillor Martin passed out a brochure about possible funding which could assist with the construction of a Cenotaph. He also gave the MCD the paperwork for the Community War Program, for future reference.

Councillor Good advised he was recently speaking with a gentleman who is a Zone Commander with area Legions. This person advised there may be other forms of funding to assist with a Cenotaph project in North Frontenac Township. Councillor Good will contact this person for further information and bring it back to the Task Force for further discussion.

All members present visited the Clar/Mill Community Hall in Plevna to view the property. It appears as though a good option for the proposed Cenotaph would be near the road on the Clar/Mill Community Hall Property as it would allow for easy access for individuals to visit the Cenotaph and for snow plows, etc... to keep the area cleaned up. It is also on higher ground therefore; would minimize the amount of fill, etc... required to make the area feasible for a monument; reducing costs within the proposed project. The MCD will consult with the Public Works Manager regarding this idea for feedback. Members will look at this property again in April when the snow is gone.

The MCD will search the internet for a local monument company and forward the link to members of the Task Force for perusal.

The next meeting of the North Frontenac Cenotaph Task Force will take place on Monday April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 9:30 am at the Clarendon Miller Fire Hall Upstairs Meeting Room.
